A copy of the agenda is available at 1901 N. Stone twenty-four hours in advance of the meeting.



- (a) Discussion or consideration of employment, assignment, appointment, promotion, demotion, dismissal, salaries, disciplining or resignation of a public officer, appointee, or employee of the public body, pursuant to A.R.S. §38-431.03(A)(1); and/or
- (b) Discussion or consideration of records exempt from public inspection, including the receipt and discussion of information or testimony that is specifically required to be maintained as confidential by state or federal law, pursuant to A.R.S. §38-431.03(A)(2); and/or
- (c) Discussion or consultation for legal advice with the attorney or attorneys for the public body, pursuant to A.R.S. §38 431.03(A)(3); and/or
- (d) Discussion or consultation with the attorneys of the public body in order to consider its position and instruct its attorney regarding the public body's position in pending or contemplated litigation, or in settlement discussions conducted in order to avoid or resolve litigation, pursuant to A.R.S. §38-431.03(A)(4).
